Greathouse Internships, General Guidelines

The Greathouse Internship is designed to be an eight-week experience and weekly hours may be structured to fit the needs of the organization and your own schedule. Internships should be completed by September 15, 2017.

- All applicants meeting criteria are welcome to apply, however preference will be given to applicants with affiliation to First United Methodist Church, Portland.
- Interns must plan to work in the same workplace under direct supervision with the organization's managers. This would include working together in an office setting or in field work.
- Internships are for a total of 200 hours paid at the rate of \$10.00 per hour, total payment of \$2,000.00.
- Intern Candidate Interviews will take place on Saturday, April 22, 2017 at FUMC
- At the end of the summer intern experience, you will be expected to present a 20-minute review to Church members in a First UMC Forum on the Greathouse Internship Program.
- Minimum Age: Applicants must be completing senior year of high school or currently a college student and 18 years of age before June 1, 2017.
